No More Band-Aids!

A Permanent Fix for Sotterley's Manor House HVAC!

Sotterley's Manor House, originally designed to be heated by fireplaces and cooled by breezes through large windows, is now serviced by an aging geothermal system. As the system has aged, there have been problems due to design flaws and wear on the pumps, jeopardizing the mansion and the furnishings. Since its installation technology has advanced and geothermal systems are more efficient and effective. Thanks to a grant from the Middendorf Foundation, Sotterley will be installing a new geothermal system to provide the critical balance needed for preservation of the building and its collections. The new unit will retrofit into the existing space and no modification to the ducts is needed. This upgrade will not only increase cooling and heating capacity but has the added benefit of decreasing electrical costs as well. Thank you Middendorf Foundation!



Sotterley Was Ready For Our Close-Up!

Maryland Public Television visited Sotterley in September to film an upcoming program about the National Park Service Underground Railroad Network to Freedom sites in Maryland. Sotterley has this designation not because it is part of the Underground Railroad, but because Sotterley has so many stories of flight and resistance. Documented examples include people like Nace and Charlie, who went with the British during the Revolutionary War; Joseph, who escaped from Sotterley more than once in the 1780s; and the Munroe and Seal families, who left with the British in 1815 during the War of 1812 to settle in Nova Scotia.
